



MANDATORY WINTER CARE FOR YOUR AUTOMATIC POOL COVER

1. The water level in the pool must not be lowered more than 5 inches from normal operating levels, this level must be maintained.
2. The cover pump must be on the cover at all times to remove water. Based on freezing, the pump will need to be monitored.
3. Leaves and debris should be removed as they accumulate on the cover because they cause excess weight and they can stain the cover.
4. DO NOT attempt to operate the cover if the pool water is low, or if the cover has water, snow or ice on it.
5. Attempting to break and remove snow or ice from the cover can cause damage to both the cover itself and/or the guides.
6. If the leading edge bar is lowered for the winter, make sure it is reset to the proper height in the spring to operate without damage.
7. We recommend your system be maintained each spring: clean the guides, lube the system and clean the cover. See Owner's Manual for details.

AUTOMATIC POOL COVER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

COVER CARE:

- Clean cover at least once a year with Coverstar Central Cleaner and Protectant.
- Patch all holes.

MECHANISM CARE: (once a month)

- Adjust unit to open and close straight
- Grease all zerk fittings on the unit
- Check pulleys for bearing wear and spray lubricant on them
- Check guide feeds, sliders and braking unit for wear
- Clean out debris from cover box

GUIDE CARE: (minimum once a month)

- Clean rope channels in guides by flushing with a garden hose.
- Do not add any lubricants

BEFORE OPERATING THE COVER:

- Make sure wheels are at proper height so the leading edge bar does not drag on the guides or the end of the pool.
- Make sure the water level is at the proper operating level for swimming before operating the cover.

Keep cover control locked and store the cover key in a safe location to prevent unauthorized operation or unsupervised access to the pool.

Standing water must be removed from cover to avoid drowning and/or damage to cover.
